



TCN Diploma Seals

1. **Ohio Means Jobs Seal-** *Meet the requirements and criteria established for the readiness seal, including demonstration of work-readiness and professional competencies.*
2. **State Seal of Biliteracy-** *Meet the requirements and criteria, including proficiency requirements on assessments in a world language and English.*
3. **Industry-Recognized Credential Seal-** *Earn an approved industry-recognized credential that is aligned to a job considered in demand in this state and its region.*
4. **College-Ready Seal-** *Earn remediation-free scores on the ACT or SAT.
(For the ACT: English = 18, Math = 22, Reading = 22, Science = 22)*
5. **Military Enlistment Seal-** *Provide evidence that a student has enlisted in a branch of the U.S. Armed Forces; or participate in an approved JROTC program.*
6. **Science Seal-** *A student can-*
 - a. *Earn a proficient or higher on the Biology end-of-course exam*
 - b. *Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exams*
 - c. *Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an appropriate class taken through the College Credit Plus program or upper level science course*
7. **Honors Diploma Seal-** *Earn one of six Honors Diplomas outlined below:*
 - a. *Academic Honor Diploma*
 - b. *International Baccalaureate Honors Diploma*
 - c. *Career-Tech Honors Diploma*
 - d. *STEM Honors Diploma*
 - e. *Arts Honors Diploma*
 - f. *Social Science and Civic Engagement Honors Diploma*

8. Citizenship Seal- *A student must satisfy one of the listed options for American History AND one for Government.*

<p>American History options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <i>Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an American History course</i>2. <i>Earn a score of proficient or higher on Ohio’s State Test in American History</i>3. <i>Earn a score equivalent to proficient on an appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate test in US History</i>4. <i>Earn a “B” or higher in appropriate American History College Credit Plus course</i>	<p>American Government options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <i>Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an American Government course</i>2. <i>Earn a score of proficient or higher on Ohio’s State Test in American Government</i>3. <i>Earn a score equivalent to proficient on an appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate test in US Government</i>4. <i>Earn a “B” or higher in appropriate American Government College Credit Plus course</i>
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9. Technology Seal- A student can:

- a. *Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on an appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exam*
- b. *Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an appropriate class taken through the College Credit Plus program*
- c. *Complete a course offered through the district or school that meets guidelines developed by the Department*

<p>Fine & Performing Arts Seal Demonstrate skills in the fine or performing arts according to an evaluation aligned with guidelines adopted by the student’s local board of education or school governing authority.</p>	<p>3 credits in Fine Arts earned in grades 9-12</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>or</i></p> <p>2 credits in Fine Arts & participation in at least one community/school performance successfully completed in grades 9-12</p>
<p>Student Engagement Seal Participate in extracurricular activities such as athletics, clubs or student government to a meaningful extent, as determined by guidelines adopted by the student’s local board of education or school governing authority.</p>	<p>Three years of meaningful participation (80% attendance) in Tri-County North High School groups/clubs, Tri-County North High School sports, or other extracurricular activities approved by the administration, teachers, and/or school counselors.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Advisors/Coaches must verify students’ 80% attendance on team rosters
