- Our commitment to student well-being is unwavering. Collaborative efforts with mental health therapists, counselors, and teachers, along with the Hope Squad services, facilitate peer-to-peer suicide prevention programs. PHYSICAL HEALTH SERVICES

- The district has employed a registered nurse (RN) to ensure that medical care and health screenings are conducted as necessary.
